Materials

- Worsted weight yarn (approximately 300 yards)
- Size H/8 (5mm) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

Gauge

4 inches = 10 stitches in half double crochet

Finished Size

Approximately 24 inches wide x 48 inches long

Instructions

1. Chain 200.
2. Half double crochet in the second chain from the hook and in each chain across. (199 stitches)
3. Continue half double crocheting in each stitch across for a total of 10 rows.
4. Fold the scarf in half lengthwise, matching up the two short ends. Sew the two ends together using a yarn needle and yarn.
5. Fold the scarf in half again, matching up the two long ends. Sew the two ends together using a yarn needle and yarn.
6. Your infinity scarf is now complete!

Tips

- For a wider scarf, chain more stitches in the beginning. For a narrower scarf, chain fewer stitches.
- For a longer scarf, continue crocheting more rows. For a shorter scarf, crochet fewer rows.
- You can use any color or type of yarn you like. For a more rustic look, use a tweed yarn. For a more elegant look, use a silk yarn.
- This scarf is also great for using up leftover yarn. Simply join different colors of yarn as you go.

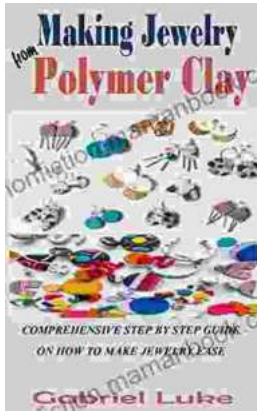
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
