Materials You'll Need:

* Aran-weight yarn in brown, cream, and black * 4mm (US 6) knitting needles * Wool stuffing * Safety eyes (10mm) * Black felt * Needle and thread * Tapestry needle * Scissors

12. **Attach the tail:** Sew the tail to the back of the body.
13. **Create the details:** Embroider the eyes using black felt and thread. Embroider whiskers using black thread.
14. **Finish:** Weave in all loose ends.

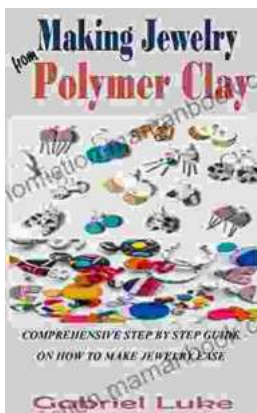
